

Electronic Notification Category Descriptions

Alternative Transportation – Discussion of modes of travel other than private cars, such as walking, bicycling, rollerblading, carpooling and transit

Alternative Fuels – Powering vehicles with fuel other than gasoline/diesel

Bicycle and Pedestrian –Bicycle and pedestrian planning

Children/Education – Learning about transportation and transportation planning

Congestion Management - Program to address and manage congestion in order to facilitate the movement of people and goods

Demographics - Population characteristics used for transportation planning

Economic Development - Policies and programs explicitly directed to meet broad economic objectives such as high employment, expanded tax base, and sustainable growth

Environmental/Conservation - Managing the environment in a manner that does not despoil, exhaust or extinguish our air or soil

Environmental Justice – Dealing with the inequitable environmental burden born by groups such as racial minorities and women

Freight/Goods Movement - Goods or produce being transported generally for commercial gain, usually on a ship, plane, train, van or truck

Intercity Transportation – Discussion of passenger airplane, bus and train topics

Land Use - How human settlement patterns impact transportation needs

Long Range Plan (LRP) – A thirty year conceptual transportation plan for the region based on current and projected transportation needs

Newsletter – The GBNRTC newsletter is produced four times a year. Featured articles and descriptions of ongoing GBNRTC projects are included

Older Drivers - Issues pertaining to seniors

Public Transit – NFTA METRO Light Rail Transportation (LRT) and bus

Safety - The condition of being protected against physical harm or any other event which could be considered non-desirable

Transportation Enhancement Program (TEP) - Capital funds for "non-traditional" transportation projects such as bicycle and pedestrian facilities, historic preservation of transportation facilities, and transportation-related landscaping and scenic beautification

Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) - A capital investment program prepared cooperatively with the State and transit operator that prioritizes transportation projects to be implemented with Federal funds over a five year period.
